

SEPTEMBER PRAYER

1 Pray that kids who spent time at camp this summer will have endurance to grow in their spiritual walk. Pray for camp staff to find jobs or direction for the remainder of their year.

2 Jonny and Melissa are spending time apart while he works on intense flight training in Idaho and she works in Saskatoon. Ask God for a healthy pregnancy.

3 Farmers have had a difficult year. Intercede for those who are discouraged or who need special grace to trust the Lord with their finances.

4 Pray for calmness and courage for each one in the midst of recent life changes: new babies, marriage, jobs, or those moving.

5 Uphold those leading music in our worship services – that they will choose music that leads us to truthful thinking about our walk with God.

6 Think of the ones you know who are grieving. Pray that they will grieve in a

healthy way that leads them to deeper trust in God despite their pain.

7 Ask God that our school-aged kids would find good friends for this school year.

8 Pray for the school teachers in our congregation to see their students with Christ's love, and to share the gospel by deed and word when they have opportunity.

9 Pray for sick people to be able to have visitors and companionship.

10 Ask God to uphold the children in our church whose parents are struggling in their marriages. Pray that God would comfort each child or teen in these situations.

11 Pray that men in our church will find other men to whom they can relate and who will inspire them to grow in their Christian walk.

12 As Sunday School begins, pray for teachers to be touched by God's Word so they can teach with sincerity.

13 Pray for those in care homes: Harvey Unger, Martha Thiessen.

14 Parents with grown children who are not following Jesus can feel like failures or that God has not been faithful to them. Pray that their hearts would be kept from becoming cynical.

15 Pray that each of our pastors will have strength to be wise and gentle husbands and fathers.

16 Ask God to help each of us make good choices in our entertainment this year.

17 Todd Bonefeole is recovering from shoulder surgery. Pray that he will spend his healing season with sensitivity to God's presence, taking time to reflect and re-evaluate.

18 Fall Fest is today. Ask God that as our community comes out, they would see Christ's light in all the fun that is planned.

19 Pastor Darryl asks prayer for wisdom in counseling others, as well as discernment

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in making decisions that don't seem to be black or white.

20 Pray for our government to have a fear of the Lord.

21 Jake and Dorothy are finding joy in their ministry in the midst of much grieving in Bolivia. Thank God for a growing church. Pray for the Fehrs to be a comfort through their presence and through the Word shared on the radio.

22 Pray that we will be people who are committed to studying and memorizing God's Word.

23 Families with young children need wisdom to teach their children, and strength to endure the demands of the season they are in.

24 Consider the grievousness of sin. Pray that we will take our sin seriously and fight for victory to overcome.

25 Today, delight in God's love for you. You are chosen, you are a joint heir with Christ of all that God has for those who are His.

26 Bring before the Lord those who are new to our church fellowship and are wondering whether our church is a good fit for them. Pray that each one will feel a sense of welcome and belonging.

27 Thank God for our church building addition and ask for His leading in using it for things of eternal value.

28 Remember the friends we have at Punnichy. Pray for salvation and spiritual growth for each one we have met there.

29 Ask God for us not to be content with a mediocre faith but that we will have tender hearts and a vibrant faith.

30 Pray for each one in our fellowship fighting depression or other mental and emotional health struggles. Pray they will get whatever support they need to be overcomers, or to endure this trial.
